S6 Study Periods

One of our safety procedures is minimising movement and tracking where our pupils are throughout the course of the day. We have asked our S6 pupils to let us know when they require a space to work in during their non-timetabled periods. Most S6 pupils have completed a google form indicating when this is the case. It is important that we know whether they plan to work at home or in school. This will allow us to make suitable arrangements including accommodation and staffing study areas. If your child is in S6, your support in reminding them to complete the form is appreciated.

Face Coverings

Wet Weather

They can remove the face covering when eating.
