FOOD

If you are struggling to feed your family and need an emergency food parcel help is available. You can contact the Aberdeen City Support Line on 0800 034 713.

NHS24

If you feel unwell over the festive period phone NHS 24 on **111** if you:

- think you need to go to A&E but it's not life threatening
- are too ill to wait for your GP practice to open
- have worsening symptoms of coronavirus

NHS 24 will help you get the right care in the right place, often closer to home and without the need to go to A&E.
